(U) IN A MEETING WITH PAO AND PESHAWAR PO, SAID ISHAQ GAILANI, PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL FOR UNDERSTANDING AND NATIONAL UNITY IN AFGHANISTAN (AN ORGANIZATION OF INDEPENDENT AFGHANS LOBBYING FOR A PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT OF THE AFGHAN CONFLICT), SPOKE WITH MUCH APPREHENSION ABOUT THE ULEMA CONFERENCE. HE BELIEVES THE TALIBAN
