Til is currently a Research Officer at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York's Research Department where he focuses on risk measurement and management in financial institutions and capital markets. Recent topics include integrated risk management and credit risk diversification. He is also a Sloan Research Fellow at the Wharton Financial Institution Center and teaches at Columbia University.
