

Anderson Caputo Silva

Anderson Silva joined the World Bank in January 2006, as a Senior Debt Specialist at the Financial Sector Operations and Policy Department. From 2001 to 2005, he was the head of the Public Debt Strategic Planning department (the middle-office) of the Brazilian Treasury, responsible, among others, for the elaboration of strategies to refinance the debt, develop the market of government securities and the design of the debt risk management framework. He also worked for four years at the front-office, where he coordinated the issuance of domestic instruments. Mr. Silva holds a Ph.D. degree in Finance from the University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana and has written policy papers covering several different topics related to debt market development and debt management.
