





Do you feel things in this country are going in the right direction, or have they gotten off on the wrong track?




If the election for President were being held today, and you had to make a choice, would you be voting for the Republican candidate or the Democratic candidate?




If the election for Congress were being held today, and you had to make a choice, would you be voting for the Republican candidate or the Democratic candidate in your district?




What do you think is the number one problem facing the country today-- that is, what is the problem that you and your family are most concerned about?




How would you rate the job that Congressional Democrats have been doing this year? Do you approve or disapprove of the job they are doing?




How would you rate the job that Congressional Republicans have been doing this year? Do you approve or disapprove of the job they are doing?




How would you rate the job George W. Bush has been doing as President – do you approve or disapprove of the job he is doing?




Whether you approve or disapprove of the way George W. Bush is handling his job as President, what is your impression of George W. Bush as a person? Do you approve or disapprove of him?




Do you believe that the situation in Iraq has—gotten better, stayed the same, or gotten worse—over the past six months?






In what party's Presidential primary election do you plan to vote – the Republican primary or the Democrat primary?




If the Republican primary election for President was held today and you had to make a choice from this list of candidates, for whom would you vote?




If the Democratic primary election for President was held today and you had to make a choice from this list of candidates, for whom would you vote?




Is there one candidate running for the Presidency who you would NOT vote for no matter what? In other words, is there one candidate who you would never consider voting for? (GOP Candidates)




Is there one candidate running for the Presidency who you would NOT vote for no matter what? In other words, is there one candidate who you would never consider voting for? (Democrat Candidates)












In thinking about the economy, how would you you rate your personal economic situation?




Thinking about your own situation, what current <u>economic</u> issue is most important in determining your vote for President?




Thinking about the American Dream and what that means to you and your family, which of these statements <u>best</u> describes your view about the American Dream:




When thinking about your own life, which of these is your top priority—


- Ensuring the financial security for you and your family, even if this means working long hours, OR
