


My friend, Sgt. Hugh Grey Willard, of Maxwell Street in Salisbury, North Carolina, was killed in an ambush in Binh Duong Province in Vietnam on December 23, 1967. Sgt. Willard was 23 years old at the time. Sgt. Willard was assigned to Military Advisory Command, Vietnam and was on Advisory Team 91 at the time of his death. He arrived in Vietnam on September 13, 1967 and then was killed on December 23, 1967. He earned the Bronze Star with the V for Valor and the Purple Heart. His information follows:
