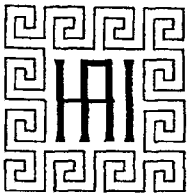

RE: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Dear Ms. Diggin:

I am writing on behalf of Texas Instruments Incorporated, successor to Metals and Controls Corporation, to request production of agency records under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552. Please provide me with the contents of the following folders from Accession 326-81-0013, "Office of General Counsel Contract Correspondence 1946-1965:"

- General Electric #52 Volume 1
- General Electric #52 Volume 2
- Metals & Controls Volume 1
- Westinghouse #14 volume 1

All of these folders appear to be located in the second box of this two-box accession, but the box number was not legible on the copy of the SF-135 for this accession. The Westinghouse and General Electric folders are identified as being classified SECRET. There is no classification indication associated with the Metals & Controls folder. These records are currently stored at the Washington National Records Center in Suitland, Maryland.

To the extent that any relevant documents are classified, I request that you declassify and/or sanitize the documents for my review. I would also appreciate receiving any materials you can release as soon as possible rather than waiting for all the responsive documents to clear your review processes.

I have already discussed the records in accession 326-81-0013 with Claude Barnes in the Office of the General Counsel, Office of Administrative Operations. He is the custodian

of these records. He indicated that once he is contacted by you, he will make every effort to expedite the review process.
