MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

DSP Tactical Support

1. (U) A meeting was held on 1 Mar 91 at HQ USSPACECOM to discuss and resolve issues related to the tactical exploitation of DSP.

- Meeting was hosted by VADM Dougherty and chaired by BG Stewart. The Component Commands, the Joint Staff and each of the Services were represented. (List of attendees is at Atch 1). The UD opened the meeting by stating:

-- This is a solution oriented meeting. I want a package to present to the CINC at the end of the meeting.

-- Our uppermost concern is the primary DSP mission. We cannot disturb it.

- USCINCSpace will provide and expand DSP tactical support to the extent that such support does not interfere with its primary (strategic) mission or the TW/AA architecture.

-- The Components must support each others' Tactical Support efforts.

-- The CINC has approved TSD. Impediments must be removed.

-- The CINC has COCOM and the responsibility to ensure Tactical Warning Support to Theater CINCs.

2. (S) Purpose of the meeting was:

- To resolve issues regarding the Army's Tactical Surveillance Demonstration (TSD) which had been approved by USCINCSpace on 20 Sep 90.

- To resolve issues regarding the Navy's Tactical Ground Station (TAGS) [ (S) ]

- To review the USSPACECOM draft MNS on TW/AA and address concepts and requirements for the future, tactical exploitation of DSP data.

3. (U) The following items were agreed on:

(U) TSD:

- AFSPACECOM will immediately release crypto keys and any other materials necessary to support the TSD experiment.

- Army accepts full custodial responsibility for such material and will specify when materials will be returned.

- AFSPACECOM was extended opportunity to take part in TSD (and other) experiments, but representatives did not indicate their intention to do so.

- SIO will participate in the TSD and any subsequent demonstration/experiment to ensure architectural integrity.

- HQ USSPACECOM personnel will also take part in the demo and related data analysis.

*U(S)* USCINCSpace AUTHORITY: All tactical exploitation experiments, demonstrations, or operations will be conducted with approval of USCINCSpace and must be in compliance with JCS policies.

- HQ USSPACECOM will prepare in writing a policy for processing and approval of such requests.

- NAVSPACECOM will prepare a request for CINC support of the TAGS effort.

*U(S)* SEPARATING STRATEGIC FROM TACTICAL SUPPORT (MISSION PROCESSING):

*U(S)* JCS POLICY DOCUMENTS: There are four separate JCS documents which impact DSP/Warning Policy, Requirements and Operations. The documents are currently published and revised independently.

- JCS/Joint Staff will work with USSPACECOM on consolidating all DSP/Warning Policies into a single document.

(U) DOWN LINK SITES: Both the Army and Navy support concept of USSPACECOM (through a component) personnel exploiting data at in-theater facilities assigned to COCOM of USCINCSpace.

- Navy did not contest USCINCSpace COCOM of TAGS facilities, but we do not believe that was Navy's original intention.

- AFSPACECOM will likely continue to argue that even if tactical data was processed independently that such processing should be done at a DSP ground station.

4. (U) RECOMMENDATION: That UD or CINC direct AFSPACECOM to release crypto and any other materials necessary to support CINC-approved TSD.
