I. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

A. OVERVIEW

- THE BOMBING CAMPAIGN IN BOGOTA BY THE ESCOBAR ORGANIZATION SUBSIDED DURING THE MONTH OF MARCH. THIS COULD BE ATTRIBUTED TO A COMBINATION OF THE UNRELENTING PRESSURE EXERTED BY THE COLOMBIAN SECURITY FORCES AND THE PEPES (PEOPLE EXPLOITED BY PABLO ESCOBAR) AGAINST ESCOBAR AND HIS ASSOCIATES. OVER THE PAST MONTH THE ESCOBAR ORGANIZATION HAS BEEN CONFIDENTIAL

OVER THE PAST 13 YEARS AN AMOIT WAS SHOT AND KILLED ON MARCH 12 IN BOGOTA, A VICITM OF AN APPARENT ROBBERY. ON MARCH 8 THERE WAS A SHOOTING IN FRONT OF THE CHANCERY BY A COLOMBIAN MILITARY POLICEMAN AT A SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE WHICH RESULTED IN ONE KILLED AND ONE WOUNDED. THE VICTIMS' MOTIVES WERE UNKNOWN BUT SUBSEQUENT INVESTIGATION INDICATES THIS INCIDENT TO BE NON-TERRORIST RELATED.

EMBASSY STILL PERCEIVES ESCOBAR AS A SERIOUS THREAT, BUT BELIEVES SECURITY SITUATION HAS EASED SOMEWHAT. SOME RESTRICTIONS REMAIN ON MISSION PERSONNEL BUT MANY HAVE BEEN MODIFIED GIVEN LACK OF SPECIFIC THREAT INFORMATION AND IMPROVED SECURITY SITUATION IN BOGOTA.

IN ADDITION TO THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED DAILY BRIEFINGS FOR TDY PERSONNEL AND NEW EMPLOYEES, RSO CONDUCTED SPECIAL BRIEFINGS FOR ALL AMERICAN CONTRACT EMPLOYEES (PIT AND PSC). BRIEFINGS WERE CONDUCTED ON SECURITY REGULATIONS AND THE PROPER HANDLING OF CLASSIFIED MATERIAL.
