subject: Historical Imagery Declassification

Study (U)
The reference sought Intelligence Community coordination on decrassification of obsolete KH-7 and KH-9 film-return satellite imagery. I sought coordination following a review as required by Executive Order 12951. The Imagery Policy and Security Committee (IPSCOM) conducted the review.
The IPSCOM uncovered no opposition to recommending the declassification of the KH-7 imagery and the KH-9 imagery; the KH-9 mapping (frame) camera. Our plan to implement the declassification, however, was intentionally vague based on uncertain funding. I have subsequently received funding, through Senator Kerrey's "Imagery for Citizens" initiative.
