

(S//TK//RBL) Pursuant to letters dated 24 October 2006 and 23 May 2007, I want to inform you that the Director of National Intelligence has concurred with my decision to declassify the "fact of" National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) Mission Ground Stations (MGS) and the "fact of" an NRO presence at the Joint Defence Facility Pine Gap, Alice Springs, Australia, and Menwith Hill Station, Harrogate, United Kingdom. The declassification will take effect on 15 October 2008.
