## MEMORANDUM FOR DIRECTOR, DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY

SUBJECT: Data on USSR Buildup in Cuba

- 1. I believe we should take all measures necessary to increase our ability to detect any future sudden Seviet buildup of military forces in Cuba. For this reason, I would like for you to conduct an analysis of shipping from the Sino-Seviet Bloc to Cuba over the past months to see if we can determine when the current build-up gained momentum, and to outline any other pegpoints that might be useful in detecting in time any reoccurence of Seviet military activity.
- 2. In addition, I would like an estimate of the number of ships required to outload the offensive military equipment of the USSR now in Cuba. The J-4 will be available to assist you in developing this estimate to the extent you desire.
- I would like to have the above data by close of business
   November or sooner, if possible.
