SUMMARY

1. ON BASIS DISCUSSIONS WITH EXTAFF, EMBASSY BELIEVES WOULD SERVE MOST USEFUL PURPOSE SEND SMALL US TEAM EXPERTS TO DISCUSS NPT WITH TOP AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS FOR TWO DAYS MIDDLE OF NEXT WEEK. AT CABINET YESTERDAY IT WAS DECIDED SUCH VISIT WOULD BE GREATLY WELCOMED.

2. EXTAFF FIRST ASST. SECY. BOOKER TOLD POLITICAL COUNSELOR THAT WHILE EXTAFF GENERALLY FAVORS AUSTRA-LIAN ADHERENCE, OTHER DEPARTMENTS HAVE SERIOUS MIS-GIVINGS WHICH EXTAFF NOT IN POSITION TO ALLAY ON BASIS ITS OWN INFORMATION. PROBLEM NOT SO MUCH ON POLITICAL SIDE AS TECHNICAL SIDE. AUSTRALIAN AEC AND MINISTRY NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT FEAR THAT AUSTRALIAN ATOMIC ENERGY INDUSTRY MAY BE FROZEN IN "PREMITIVE STATE." PRINCIPAL GOA CONCERNS AND MISGIVINGS LIE IN FIELD OF PEACEFUL USES ATOMIC EXPLOSIVES, ATOMIC

- 3. ACCORDING BOOKER, EXTAFF WOULD LIKE GOA TO BE IN POSI-TION OF ACTIVELY SUPPORTING NPT, BUT UNDER PRESENT CIRCUM-STANCES FURTHEST IT COULD GO WOULD BE NOT TO OPPOSE. IF GOA IS TO BE IN POSITION TO INSTRUCT ITS UNGA DELEGATION TO ACT POSITIVELY, GOVERNMENT OPINION MUST BE CRYSTALLIZED BY END OF WEEK FOLLOWING EASTER.
- 4. IT WOULD NOT HELP TO SEND AUSTRALIAN TEAM TO US. HOWEVER, VISIT TO CANBERRA OF LEADING AEC OFFICIAL WHO COULD
 OFFER GUIDANCE ON CIVIL USES ATOMIC ENERGY, ACCOMPANIED
 BY SOMEONE FROM ACDA WHO COULD SPEAK TO INTERPRETATION OF
 NPT, COULD DO MUCH, HE FEELS, TO ALLAY FEARS OF CERTAIN
 MINISTERS. THEY ARE THE ONES WHO MUST BE CONVINCED. MOREOVER, MINISTERS IN CABINET YESTERDAY DECIDED THEY WOULD WELCOME SUCH VISIT. IF MEETINGS CAN BE SCHEDULED SUFFICIENTLY
 IN ADVANCE, ONE DAY OF DISCUSSIONS WITH MINISTERS SHOULD
