Submit an official or unofficial transcript through the last quarter/semester completed from all colleges and universities attended to the Office of Graduate Student Assistantships and Fellowships at The George Washington University, Washington, D.C. 20052. Students must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.4 or more to qualify for a fellowship and be willing to study full-time in an applicable graduate program on the Foggy Bottom campus. Priority is given to full-time students; part-time students will be considered, if funding is available. U.S. citizenship is required, and affiliation must be with a U.S. Scottish Rite organization.
2. Attach a two page personal essay with your application. Elaborate fully on your career goals, both short- and long-term. Use this essay to enlarge on any answers to questions in the application that will enhance your qualifications or background experiences. Students are selected on the basis of goals, scholastic attainment, participation in extracurricular activities, community service, personal recommendations, character, and leadership potential.
3. Three original letters of recommendation are required. Photocopies will not be accepted.
4. Scottish Rite Endowment Graduate Fellowships become official only when the applicant is accepted to a graduate program in the School of Business, the Elliott School of International Affairs, the School of Engineering and Applied Science, the Graduate School of Education and Human Development, the Columbian College of Arts and Science, or the School of Public Health and Health Services at The George Washington University **on the Foggy Bottom campus**.
5. A relationship with the Scottish Rite is required. Either the applicant's grandfather, father, uncle, self, or spouse must be or have been a member of the Scottish Rite. Please supply the following information:
