Memorandum

of the deliberations of the

PLENARY SESSION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH SOCIALIST REPUBLIC

which took place on 25 January 1989

(3rd session)

The meeting was chaired by the Premier.

The government, after hearing reports by V. Jireček, J. Krupauer, and A. Kašpar on the events in Prague of January 15 to 21, 1989:

a) **declared** that the vast majority of our citizens condemn these actions, and that our socialist society provides sufficient room for the broad democratic pursuit of the interests and opinions of all citizens; it decisively rejected these attempts to destabilize our society,

b) **supported** the decisive measures taken by the security units of Public Security and the People's Militia which have led to the restoration of calm and public order.
