This is response to your 3 September 2002, Freedom of Information Act request regarding your Archive FOIA Request No. 20020484AIR006.

The Office of The Judge Advocate surfaced five responsive documents. Three documents are released; however, the remaining two documents are withheld in full. The authority for withholding is Title 5, United States Code, Section 552, (b)(5). Exemption 5 applies to attorney-client communications, pre-deliberative communications, and/or material prepared in anticipation of litigation.

The denial authority in this instance is Mr. Richard A. Peterson, Deputy, Chief, General Law Division, Office of The Judge Advocate General.


