Use It For: Finding and using books online on a variety of topics.

Why Use It? Because you can use books, anytime and anywhere, without coming to the library!

Step 1

You can find some of our books in the ALADIN Catalog, <http://catalog.wrlc.org>. They are marked with "[electronic resource]" after the title.

Step 2

To access one of these books, click on GW's title. Scroll to the bottom of the record page, and click on the "Click here to access this book" link.

Using ebrary for the first time?

You will need to download the ebrary Reader. Follow the steps below to install the Reader for Internet Explorer:

1. "Click here to install the following Active X Control 'ebrary Reader' from "ebrary"
2. Click on the "Install" button
3. Check the "I accept" box and click on "Accept"
4. The book should open up in the new window.
