Columbian College (CCAS) Students must satisfy GCRs in 7 categories:

Literacy: UW20 (University Writing) 2 WID courses (Writing in the Discipline)

Quantitative and Logical Reasoning: (6 hours/2 courses in MATH, STAT, or LOGIC)

Natural Sciences: (9-12 hours/3 courses with labs in at least 2 different sciences)

Social and Behavioral Sciences: (6 hours/2 courses)

Creative and Performing Arts (3 hours)

Humanities: (12 hours/4 courses in at least two fields of study)

Foreign Language or Culture: (6-8 hours/2 courses)
