Dear Mrs. Roodevalt:

I note from the press that on last Sunday afternoon, December 7, on the ABC television program College Hews Conference, you stated, among other things, that Senator Kennedy's "father has been spending codies of money all over the country and probably has a paid representative in every state by now."

Because I know of your long fight against the injudicious use of falce statements, rumors or immendo as a means of injuring the reputation of an individual, I am certain that you are the victim of misinformation; and I am equally certain that you would want to ask your informant if he would be villing to make me one such representative or one such example of any spending by my father around the country on my behalf.

I swalt your answer, and that of your source, with great interest. Whatever other differences we may have had, I'm certain that we both regret this kind of political practice.
