Include your academic objectives, research interests, and career plans. Also discuss your related qualifications, including collegiate, professional, and community activities, and any other substantial accomplishments not already mentioned on the application.
- Additional requirements:** Interview requested when possible. Portfolio required. (Portfolio must be mailed directly to GW Arts Therapy Program, 1925 Ballenger Avenue, Suite 250, Alexandria, VA 22314)
- International applicants only:** Please review [International Applicant Information](#) carefully for details on required documents, earlier deadlines for applicants requiring an I-20 or DS-2019 from GW, and English language requirements.
