## GET PREPARED

### Important Safety Tips

- Carry your **GWORLD CARD** at all times for identification and access on campus.
- **REPORT** any unusual activity or out-of-place objects to the University Police Department.
- Know your local **EMERGENCY PLANS** and procedures, including evacuation routes. Always evacuate if a fire alarm sounds.
- Assume if an incident occurs on campus that you should **SHELTER-IN-PLACE** (remain inside) unless you are directed to do otherwise or the building is unsafe.
- Have an emergency communications plan. **PROGRAM I.C.E. INTO YOUR CELL PHONE.** I.C.E. stands for In Case of Emergency, and should be the name and number of a friend or family member.
