**Summer Research Opportunities  
In Chemistry**

The A. D. Britt and Madeleine Reines Jacobs Scholarships honor outstanding GW students in the field of chemistry by supporting summer research opportunities in one of the Department's research laboratories. Having selected a research advisor from among the chemistry faculty, the award winner and research mentor then choose a suitable research project, which is to be completed during the summer in the laboratory of the advisor. A written report, describing the results of the investigation, is required at the completion of the summer research project.

This year we expect to award at least four scholarships, valued at \$2,000.00 each. The criteria for the selection of the recipients is as follows:

- **Students must be a declared chemistry major at The George Washington University.**
- **Candidates must have a minimum overall GPA (grade point average) of 3.00.**
- **Candidates must also have a minimum GPA of 3.00 in the sciences.**
- **In order to be eligible, applicants must have completed Chem. 22, 151, 152, 153, and 154 by the end of the Spring 2008 Semester.**
- **Students enrolled in the BA/MD program are not eligible.**

Written applications must be submitted to Professor Hilderbrandt (304 Samson Hall) by Friday, February 22th. These requests should be a brief letter of interest, but must include your GPA, your grades in completed chemistry courses, and the name of a research advisor who has agreed to serve as your research mentor. (There is **no** formal application form.) Award winners will be notified no later than March 1.
