*The program provides a stipend for each participant. The stipend is divided into two parts. The first part is a \$1,000 grant to pay for Portuguese lessons before the regular semester begins in Brazil. The second part is a grant of \$2,600 to pay for the U.S.-Brazil international travel and to help pay for daily living expenses in Brazil during the semester.

Each participant will pay the normal tuition at his/her home university. Having done so, the student will be exempt from paying tuition at the Brazilian university at which he/she is spending a semester.
