

- E. Even after the exermous task is completed of deciding which operations we want, which should be left to the Army, and which should be liquidated, there still remains what appears the most difficult jeb of sile the actual transfer and liquidation. With an erganization as closely-knit and as nationalistic as this one, complete liquidation is highly improbable. Honetheless, control of operating funds will exact a certain amount of pressure on the top echelon German leaders.
