WE WOULD HAVE WISHED THAT AMBASSADOR NEGROPONTE MIGHT CONTINUE FOR A WHILE LONGER IN HONDURAS, ESPECIALLY GIVEN THE EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH WE ARE PRESENTLY LIVING. IN THE MIDDLE OF THE DRAMATIC WHIRLWIND THAT IS SWEEPING CENTRAL AMERICA, THE HONDURAN PEOPLE WILL HOLD ELECTIONS IN NOVEMBER OF THIS YEAR, AND ALL NECESSARY EFFORTS WILL BE MADE SO THAT THIS POPULAR EXPRESSION WILL STRENGTHEN OUR REPRESENTATIVE INSTITUTIONS. AND SHOW THE WORLD THAT WE ARE A COUNTRY THAT FIGHTS FOR FREEDOM AND JUSTICE.

IN LIGHT OF THIS, MR. PRESIDENT, THE MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THIS LETTER IS TO CONFIRM, ON THE PART OF GOVERNMENT THAT I LEAD BY THE WILL OF THE HONDURAN PEOPLE, THE PRAISEWORTHY JOB PERFORMED BY AMBASSADOR NEGROPONTE FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FRATERNAL RELATIONS THAT EXIST BETWEEN HONDURAS AND THE U.S.A.

I TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY, MR. PRESIDENT, TO RENEW MY EXPRESSIONS OF DISTINGUISHED CONSIDERATION AND PERSONAL ESTEEM.
