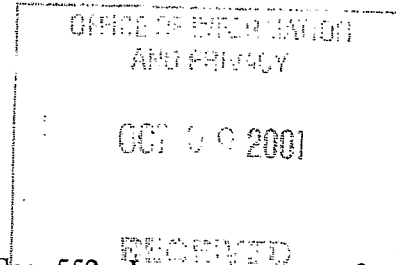

Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

To Ms. Pustay:



This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. Sec. 552. I request a copy of your agency's documents relating to, or interpretations of, the Attorney General Guidelines for Domestic Terrorism Investigations and the Attorney General Guidelines for International Terrorism Investigations. This FOIA request seeks information different from the FOIA request I submitted on September 28th (attached). In that request, I sought the text of the two guidelines. In this request, I seek documents relating to or interpreting those guidelines.

In order to help determine my status to assess fees, you should know that I am a representative of a public interest organization that publishes or disseminates information and this request is made as part of information gathering and not for a commercial use.

I am aware that I am entitled to make this request under the Freedom of Information Act, and if your agency response is not satisfactory, I am prepared to make an administrative appeal. Please indicate to me the name of the official to whom such an appeal should be addressed.

I am aware that if my request is denied I am entitled to know the grounds for this denial.

If you determine that portions of responsive documents are exempt from disclosure under the FIOA, please release to me the segregable portions that remain after the exempted material has been deleted from the data that I am seeking.

I request a waiver of all fees for this request. Disclosure of the requested information to me is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government, and is not primarily in my commercial interest, nor a business trying to get information on industrial competitors.

If you deny a request for a waiver, please be advised that I am willing to pay fees for this request up to a maximum of \$25.00. If you estimate that the fees will exceed this limit, please inform me first.
