MEMORANDUM FOR: THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE
 SUBJECT: The POLK Murder Case

1. Recent stories in the Greek and the American press have hinted at a solution of the POLK case, citing the arrest of Gregorios STAKTOPOULOS and several members of his family. []

[] However, there have been one or two developments of interest in connection with the STAKTOPOULOS arrest.

2. STAKTOPOULOS, a Communist journalist and graduate of the American College in Greece, had recently been employed as a local correspondent by the Athens manager of the Reuters News Agency. Prior to this, he was known to be connected with a communist publication in Salonika. []

3. Salonika police arrested STAKTOPOULOS in mid-August. He has since reportedly admitted membership in the Communist "self-defense" organization. []

4. More recent information is that the STAKTOPOULOS family has admitted having entertained POLK at its home in Salonika shortly before he disappeared. []
