Sources had daily contact with SUBJECT over a period of five weeks. All included information is based on direct observations by Sources with the exception of Items 4, 5, 7 through 11, 14, 15, 17, 22, 23, 25, 26, 34 through 37, and 43 through 50, which was furnished by SUBJECT.

- b. Best ways of gaining subject's confidence and exerting influence on him.

SUBJECT'S confidence can be gained by being friendly and by using a logical, mature approach.

LIMA is a very competent officer with an extremely good reputation in the Army, and is well respected by HIS contemporaries. SUBJECT'S family has money, and HE lives in an expensive district of Guatemala City. Since SUBJECT'S father is a retired Army Colonel, HE probably has personal and political connections which could help HIS military career. However, LIMA does not rely on this, but relies on HIS own ability. SUBJECT has great military potential due to HIS ability. Coupled with the political and personal connections of HIS father and HIMSELF, SUBJECT also could have extremely good political potential.
