B. HEAMOTORN'S SUMMARY: APPROXIMATELY 300 OFFICERS HAVE ALREADY BEEN REASSIGNED WITHEN THE ARMED FORCES AND ANOTHER 100 ARE EXPECT-ED TO BE TRANSFERRED WITHIN THE NEXT 30-45 DAYS. THESE MASSIVE OFFICER REASSIGNMENTS ARE PART OF BG JOSE (FRAIN (RIOS) WONTE'S PLAN TO CONSCLIDATE HIS POWER BASE WITHIN THE ARMED FORCES AND DIFFUSE ALLEGED COUNTERCOUP PROTAGONISTS. DISSATISFACTION WITHIR SEGMENTSSOF THE JUNIOR OFFICER CORPS CONTINUES. HOWEVER, THIS DIS-CONTENT IS DIVIDED ANONE TWO DEFFERENT GROUPS: (1) THOSE JUNIOR OFFICERS WHO SUPPORTED THE COUP AND WHO BELIEVE THAT BG RIOS IS VACILLATING OVER NEW ELECTION DATES, AND (2) THOSE JUNIOR OFFICENS WHO DID NOT SUPPORT THE COUP AND HAVE SINCE LOST THEIR "CUSHY"
JOBS, BOTH BROUPS ARE ALLEGEDLY BEING COURTED BY NEMBERS OF THE

MOVINENTO CE LIBERACION NACIONAL (NLA) POLITICAL PARTY WHO HOPE

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TO FIRST DIVIDE THE ARMED FORCES AND THEN TAKE OWER THE REINS OF GOVERNMENT WHEN THE JUNTA FALLS. DESPITE THIS CONTINUING DIS-SENSION, THE HIERARCHIAL CHAIN-OF-COMMAND APPEARS TO BE REESTAB-LISHING ITSELF, AND DISCEPLINE WITHIN THE ARNED FORCES IN GENERAL AND MHONG JUNIOR OFFICERS IN PARTICULAR HAS NOT POSED A SERIOUS PROBLEM AS OF YET. FEMALLY, BS RIGS ALLEGEDLY MET WITH POLITICAL PARTY REPRESENTATIVES DURING THE FIRST WEEK OF APRIL TO FFER THEM THE OPPORTUNITY TO REVISE THE ELECTORA LAW AND THAT HE (BG RIOS) WOULD GUARANTEE THAT ELECTIONS WOULD BE HELD SIX MONTHS FROM THE DATE THAT THEY (POLITICAL PARTIES) PRESENTED DEVISIONS. IN WEICH THEY ALL CONCURRED.

9. -(C/MOFORN)-DETAILS: (ENTIRE TEXT DONFIDENTIAL/MOFORN) (1) OFFICER CORPS REASSIGNMENTS: SINCE THE 23 MARCH COUP D'ETAT BG JOSE EFRAIN (REOS) MONTT HAS AFTENPTED TO COMSOLIDATE HIS POWER BASE WITHIN THE ARMED FORCES THROUGH LARGE SCALE OFFICER REASSIGN-MENTS. TO DATE, APPROXIMATELY 300 OFFICERS HAVE BEEN TRANSFERRED WITH 170 OF THESE INCLUDED IN THE MENISTRY OF DEFENSE (MOD) GENERAL CROER NUMBER 10 WHICH WAS RELEASED ON 12 APRIL. ALLEGEDLY, APPROXI-MATELY 100 MORE OFFICERS WILL BE SHIFTED WITHIN THE NEXT MONTH TO COMPLETE THE MASSIVE REORGANIZATIONAL PLAN. IN ADDITION, ORDER MANUER 10 SUPPOSEDLY INCLUDES THE REASSIGNMENT OF SEVERAL OFFICERS WHO WERE STRONGLY TIED TO PRESEDENT FERNANCO ROMED (LUCKS) GARCIA'S GOVERNMENT AND WHO HAD HANGED TO RETAIN THEER JOBS FOLLOWING THE COUP, THEREY RAISING THE ICE OF MANY JUNIOR OFFICERS WHO FELT THAT THESE OFFICERS SHOULD HAVE BEEN IMMEDIATELY REASSIGN ED ON 23 MARCH. AT LEAST TWO OF THE AFOREMENT JONED "LUCAS" CLIQUE OFFICERS, COLONEL HECTOR ISKAEL (MONTALVAN) BATRES, FORNER CHIEF, PRESEDENTEAL STAFF; AND COLONEL AUGUSTO AMECNIO (BATRES) BARREDA, FORMER DERECTOR, CIVIL AVIATION, ARE ALSO RELATED (THROUGH MARRIAGE) TO 86 REDS, WHICH PROMPTED SOME JUNEOR DE-FICERS INITIALLY TO ACCUSE THE JUNTA PRESIDENT OF MEPOTESM WHEN THESE OFFICERS RETAINED THEIR POSITIONS FOLLOWING THE COUP. COL MONTALVAN IS NOW ALLEGEDLY SLATED TO ATTEND THE INTER-ANERICAN DEFENSE COLLEGE, VASHINGTON, DC WHILE COL BATRES REMAINS TEMPORARILY UNASSIGNED. TO AVOID ANY FURTHER DISSENT BG RIOS NADE SEVERAL CHANGES TO ORDER MUMBER 10, AL-LEGEDLY REMOVING THE MANES OF OTHER FAMILY NEMBERS WHO HAD BEEN ASSIGNED TO "MEY" POSITION (NFI), FINALLY, ORDER NUMBER 10 INCLUDES THE REASSIGNMENT OF ALL SIX JUNTA ADVISERS TO ESTABLISHED MILITTARY BILLETS, THEREBY EFFECTIVELY ENDING THIS GROUP'S ADVISORY BOLE TO THE JUNTA. A SEPARATE GENERAL ORDER VILL SUPPOSEDLY BE PUBLISHED LATER THIS MONTH OFFICIALLY TER-KINATING THE TITLES AND POSITIONS OF "JUNTA ADVISERS." TWO OF THE SIX ADVISERS WILL BE REASSIGNED AS FOLLOWS: COLONEL VICTOR MAMJAL (ARGUETA) VILLALTA, CHIEF, PRESIDENTIAL STAFF, AND FIRST CAPTAIN CARLOS RODOLFO (NEMOZ) PILONA, S-3 OFFICER, PRESIDENTIAL STAFF. THE ELIMINATION OF THE JUNTA ADVISER POSITIONS WAS THE DECISION OF BG REOS WHO HAD ALLEGEDLY BECOME IRRITATED BY THE CONSTANT DEMANDS PRESENTED BY THIS GROUP WHICH WAS ACTING AS THE PRINCIPAL VOICE OF THE JUNIOR OFFICER CORPS. INSTIALLY. BG AIOS DUTIFULLY LISTEMED TO THE DIVERSIFIED POINTS OF VIEW PRESENTED BY THE SIX-MAN GROUP; HOMEVER, AT RECENT JUNTA MEETINGS BG RIOS HAS HAD TO USE HIS MILITARY SENTORITY AND POSITION AS JUNTA PRESIDENT TO TERMINATE DISCUSSIONS WHEN THE ADVISORY GROUP ATTEMPTED TO PRESSURE THE JUNIA INTO ACCEPTING THEIR VISHES. AS THE GROUP CONTINUED TO CHALLENGE HIS AATHORETY AND DISRUPT NEETINGS. THE GENERAL DICIDED TO TERMINATE THE "RULE BY CONNITTIE" PROCESS AND REASSIGN ALL SIX OFFICERS.

(?) DISSATISFACTION COMMUES: AT THE PRESENT THERE ARE TWO SEG-MENTS OF THE JUNIOR OFFICER CORPS THAT REWALL DISPLEASED WITH THE STATUS QUO, UNE GROUP IS MADE UP OF JUNIOR OFFICERS WHO SUPPORTED THE COUP BUT WHO DO NOT BELLIVE THAT BG RIOS AND THE JUNTA AREHOVING OUTCKLY ENOUGH TOWARDS NEW ELECTIONS. THESE OFFICERS ARE CONCERNED THAT THE GOG JUNTA GOVERNMENT IN GENERAL AND BG RIOS IN PARTICULAR ARE SETTLING IN FOR A LONG STAY IN POWER. WHILE THESE SAME OFFICERS NOW REALIZE THAT THEIR INITIA HOPE FOR ELECTIONS WITHIN 30-60 DAYS WAS UNREALISTIC, THEY ARE NOT PREDISPOSED TO ACCEPT A 2-3 YEAR WAIT FOR A CIVILIAN GOVERN

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MENT, SUPPOSEDLY, A SPOKEHAN FOR THES GROUP TOLD.

\*WE STAGED THIS COUP TO STOP ANOTHER MILITARY MAN FROM ASSUMING POWER ("CONTINUESNO") AND NOT SIMPLY TO REPLACE HIX WITH OTHER KILITARY NEW." THE SECOND GROUP OF ANGRY JUNIOR OFFICERS IS ALLEGEDLY MADE UP OF 46 CAPTINS/LIEUTENANTS WHO WERE FORMERLY ASSIGNED TO THE PRESIDENTIAL STAFF AND GUARD WHO HAVE LOST THEIR "CUSHY" JOBS AND ARE TO BE SUPPOSEDLY REASSIGNED TO TACTICAL UNITS. THIS GROUP MET WITH 8G RIOS ON 1-2 APRIL AND PRESENTED A LIST OF DEMANDS (NFI) WHICH, IF NOT ACCEPTED, WOULD RESULT IN THE GROUP SUBNITTING THEIR RESIGNATIONS IN MASS. IF MEITHER THE DEMANDS NOR RESIGNATIONS WERE ACCEPTED THEN BG RIOS WOULD BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE "ACTIVE RESISTANCE" (MFI) THAT MOULD FOL-LOW. BG RIOGS ALLEGEDLY RESPONDED THAT HE WOULD WEITHER ACCEPT

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THEIR DEMANDS NOR ACCEPT THEIR RESIGNATIONS AND IF THERE WAS ANY ATTEMPTED RESISTANCE ON THEIR PART TO COMPLY WITH ORDERS ESSUED BY THE JUNTA THEY WOULD BE PUNISHED TO THE FULL EXTENT OF THE LAW.

BOTH DISSATISFIED GROUPS APPEAR TO BE HADE UP OF JUNIOR OFFICERS FROM UNITS IN AND NEAR THE CAPITAL CITY. OFFICERS OF UNITS OUTSIDE THE CAPITAL HAVE NOT INTERESTED THEMSELVES WITH THE DIGODING POLITICAL BATTLES BUT ARE ANXIOUS TO RESUME MILITARY OPERATIONS AGAINST THE GURRELLAS BEFORE THEY (GUERRILLAS) CAN FULLY TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE RECENT "LULL" IN THE MILITARY'S PROS-ECUTION OF THE WAR. 8G RECS CONSIDERS THAT THE FERST WEEK TO TEN DAYS FOLLOWING THE ISSUANCE OF ORDER NUMBER 10 WILL BE CRITICAL AND MAY WELL DETERNINE IF THE GOS JUNTA GOVERNMENT VILL SURVIVE IN THE NEAR TERM. DURING THIS PERIOD, THE LARGE NUMBER OF GF-FICERS (170) REASSIGNED BY ORDER NUMBER TO WILL BE REQUIRED TO REPORT TO THEIR NEW ASSIGNMENTS. IF GROUPS OF OFFICERS REFUSE TO OBEY THE GENERAL ORDER, IT COULD PRECIPITATE A VIOLENT CONFRONTATION OR AT THE VERY LEAST CAUSE A SERIOUS BREAKDOWN IN MILITARY DISCIPLINE, WHICH WOULD SHARPLY DIVIDE THE MILITARY AND GREATLY BENEFIT THE GUERRILLAS. DESPITE THE AFOREMENTIONED CONSEQUENCES, BG RIOS WAS CONFIDERT THAT THE ORDER WOULD BE OBEYED, AND ALTHOUGH THE "GRUNBLING" WOULD CONTINUE, NO CON-FRONTATION WOULD TAKE PLACE. HE (RIOS) WAS ALSO CERTAIN THAT THE RECENT OFFICIAL VISITS MADE BY NEMBERS OF THE JUNTA TO ALL THE MAJOR MILITARY GARRISONS WAS BENEFICIAL IN AIDING THE DF-FICER CORPS TO BETER UNDERSTAND THE OBJECTIVES OF THE NEW GOVERN-WENT AND THE IMPENDING LARGE-SCALE TRANSFERS.

(3) MLN AGITATION: THE MOVIMIENTO DE LIBERACION MACIONAL (MLN)

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POLITICAL PARTY HAVING BEEN EFFECTIVELY EXCLUDED FROM ANY POST-TION OF INFLUENCE BY BS RIOS HAS ATTEMPTED TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE ONGOING CONTROVESY WITHIN THE JUNIOR OFFICER CORPS BY AC-TIVELY PURSUING BOTH GROUPS (PARA 2) OF DISSATISFIED OFFICERS. MLN GOALS ARE TO BRING DOWN THE JUNTA AND HAVE THEIR OWN LEADERS INSERTED 19TO POSITIONS OF POWER. MLN REPRESENTATIVES HAVE ER-COURAGED THE GROUP OF JUNIOR OFFICERS WHO SUPPORTED THE COUP BUT ARE NOW UNHAPPY WITH THE PERCEIVED DELAY IN AMNOUNCING ELECTORAL DATES TO PETITION THE JUNTA TO ANNOUNCE AN ELECTORAL TIMETABLE 50 THAT THE PEOPLE OF GUATEMALA WILL NOT LOSE THEIR NEW-FOUND RE-SPECT FOR THE MILITARY. SINCE ONE OF THE MAJOR REASONS FOR THE COUP WAS TO INSERT A "CIVILIAN GOVERNMENT," THE JUNIOR OFFICERS HAD EVERY RIGHT TO DEMAND THAT THE JUNTA CONSIDER THIS A FERST PRIORITY. IF THE JUNTA DOES NOT WORK TOWARD THIS END INMEDI-ATELY, THEN THE JUNIOR OFFICERS HAVE BEEN BETRAYED AND HAVE EVERY RIGHT TO REMOVE THE JUNTA AND REPLACE IT WITH OTHER PEOPLE (READ NUN) WHO WOULD ORGANIZE FREE ELECTIONS IN THE NAR TERM. REGARDING THE SECOND GROUP OF OFFICERS WHO (1) DID NOT SUPPORT THE COUP, (2) HAVE SINCE LOST THEIR "CUSHY" 3085, AND (3) HAVE NOW BEEN TRANSFERRED TO TACTICAL UNITS, MLN REPRESENTATIVES HAVE TRIED TO CURRY THEER FAVOR BY STATING THAT THE WASS TRANS-FERS WERE NOT FAIR. THAT THESE JUNIOR OFFICERS HAD BEEN FAITH-FULLY FOLLOWING THE CROERS OF THEIR SENIORS AND SHOULD THEREFORE NOT BE PUNISHED FOR THE CORRUPT ACTS OF OTHERS, AND THAT THESE TRANSFERS WERE JUST A WAY FOR THE JUNTA MEMBERS TO ENSURE THAT THEY COULD STAY IN POWER BY SURROUNDING THEMSELVES WITH THEIR OWN PEOPLE. THEREFORE, THE OFFICERS HAD EVERY RIGHT NOT TO AC-CEPT THEIR ORDERS AND DEMAND THAT THEY NOT BE MADE TO SUFFER FOR THE MESDEEDS OF OTHERS. BY SHOWING FAVOR FOR BOTH SIDES THE MAIN HOPES TO CREATE A SCHISM WITHIN THE JUNIOR OFFICER CORPS. BRING DOWN THE JUNTA, AND THEN HAVE THE JUNIOR DEFTICERS COME TO THE MLM TO FORM A NEW GOVERNMENT.

(4) MILITARY DISCIPLINE: ONE OF THE MAJOR CONCERNS OF SENIOR OF-FICERS WITHIN THE ARMED FORCES FOLLOWING THE 23 MARCH COUP WAS HOW EVENTS OF THAT DAY WOULD AFFECT DISCIPLINE AND RESPECT THERE WAS NO QUATION THAT FOR FOR AUTHORITY. THE FIRST WEEK FOLLOWING THE COUP MILITARY DISCIPLINE BROKE DOWN. THE REFUSAL BY SOME DIRTS TO ACCEPT HEMLY MAKED COMMANDERS TO-GETHER WITH ISOLATED INCIDENTS OF JUNIORS VERBALLY ABUSING SEN-TORS WERE EXAMPLES OF THE INITIAL DISCIPLINE PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED. HOWEVER, DURING THE LAST TWO WEEKS RESPECT FOR THE CHAIN OF COMMAND APPEARED TO BE RETURNING, AND INCEDENTS SUCH AS THOSE MENTIONED ABOVE HAD NOT RECCURRED. THE INT PROBLEM AND GRADUAL RETURN TO MORMALCY TO TWO FACTORS: FIRST, THE SUCCESS OF THE COUP GAVE THE JUNIOR OFFICERS A SEND OF POW-ER OVER THEIR SUPERIORS. THIS WAS TRANSLATED INTO HOSTILITY TOWARDS SENIOR OFFICERS, EXPECIALLY THOSE BELIEVES TO BE CORRUPT AND/OF POOR COMMANDERS. HOMEYER, AS THE JUNTA CONTINUED MAKING COMMAND CHANGES AND THE INITIAL EUPHORIA OF 23 MARCH \$835 -2-6. THE JUNIOR OFFICERS BEGAN TO FALL BACK INTO LINE, SECOND, BG RIOS VESITED MOST CUARTELS AND SPOKE TO BOTH JUNIORS AND SENIORS, EMPHASIZING THE NEED FOR OBEYANCE OF ORDERS AND RESPECT FOR AUTHORSTY. HE ALSO STATED HE WOULD NOT TOLERATE CONTINUING DISOBED-TENCE AND THAT HE WOULD FERSONALLY SEE TO IT THAT MAY OFFICER WHO DISOBEYED LAWFUL ORDERS FROM A SUPERIOR WOULD BE PROSECUTED ACCORDINGLY, SUPPOSEDLY, BG REGS' COMMENTS HAD SONEWHAT OF A SCREATING EFFECT ON THE JUNIOR OFFICERS AND GREATLY CONTRIBUTED TO THE LACK OF INCIDENTS SENCE THE FIRST WEEK FOLLOWING THE COUP. THE PRESENT SITUATION MAY BE THE "CALM BEFORE THE STORM". IF THE MASS TRANSFER ARE MOT ACCEPTED, OR IF THE MLM SUCCEEDS IN THEIR ATTEMPTS AT BRINGING ABOUT A CONFRONTATION, THE ARMED FORCES COULD VERY WELL DESTROY ITSELF INTERNALLY, ANY STREABLE ACT OF DISOBEDIENCE FROM ANY GROUP COULD SPARK A BLOODY CONFRONTATION WHICH WOULD TAKE YEARS TO CORRECT. LE A SERIOUS DIVISION OCCURRED AT THIS TIME WITHIN THE ARMED FORCES THE GUERRILLAS WOULD BE ABLE TO WALK INTO GUATEMALA CITY UNMOLESTED.

(5) FUTURE OF OUSTED GENERALS AND COLONELS: IN THE NEXT 2-3

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MONTHS THE GOG MILITARY JUNTA WILL REVIEW THE RECORDS AND PER-FORMANCE OF THOSE BENERAL OFFICERS AND COLONELS WHO WERE REMOVED FROM THEIR JOBS AND SENT HOME ("DISPONSIBLE"). SOME OFFICERS WILL ALLEGEBLY BE ALLOWED TO RETURN TO ACTIVE OUTY WHILE OTHERS WILL BE RETTRED. THOSE WHO HAVE INVOLVED THEMSELVES IN ACTS OF CORR-UPTION WILL BE PROSECUTED AND EITHER THROWN OUT WITHOUT PAY OR JAILED, DEFENDING ON THE SERIOUSNESS OF THEIR CRIMES. IMMEDIAT-ELY FOLLOWING TTE COUP, SOME SENSOR OFFICERS WHO DID NOT APPROVE OF THE ACTIONS OF 23 MARCH REQUESTED TO BE RETIRED; HOWEVER, BG RIOS REFUSED TO GRANTS THE RETIREMENTS FOR TWO REASONS. FIRST, HE WANTED TO BE SURE THAT BEFORE ANY OFFICER WAS ALLOWED TO RETIRE IT COULD BE PROVEN THAT THE OFFICER HAD MIT STOLEN FROM THE GOV-ERMMENT, SECOND, SINCE THERE MIGHT BE A NEED FOR SOME OF THESE OFFICERS TO BE RETURNED TO ACTIVE DUTY HE (RICS) DID NOT WANT TO LOSE EXPERTISE WHICH MIGHT LATER BE NEEDED TO HELP ORGANIZE THE NEW GOVERNMENT AND/OR ARMED FORCES. 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

(6) EG RIOS AND THE POLITICOS: SOME TIME DURING THE FIRST WEEK OF APRIL, BG RIOS ALLEGEDLY NET WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL DULY RECOGNIZED POLITICAL PARTIES. THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WAS TO PRESENT THE FOLIOWING CHALLENGE: IF IN THE NEXT 3 MONTHS THE PARTIES COULD COME UP WITH REVISIONS TO THE ELECTORAL LAWS WHICH THEY COULD ALL AGREE TO. BG RIOS WOULD GUARANTEE TO CALL ELECTIONS SIX MONTHS FROM THE DOATE THAT THOSE REVISIONS WERE PRESENTED TO HIN, HOWEVER, BG RIO SUPPOSEDLY WENT ON TO STATE THAT IF AT THE END OF THE 90 DAY PERIOD, THE PARTIES COULD NOT PRODUCE REVISIONS WHICH THEY ALL CONCURRED IN, HE (B6 RIOS) WOULD THEN FORM HIS OWN ELECTOR-AL REVISION COMMITTEE TO WORK ON THE NECESSARY CHANGES. IF THE LATTER COURSE OF ACTION WERE FOLLOWED, ELECTIONS MIGHT BE DELAYED BY AS MUCH AS ONE TO ONE AND ONE HALF YEARS FROM THE TIME RICS COMMITTEE BEGAN ITS WORK, FOLLOWING THE DEPARTURE OF THE POLIT-TOAL REPRESENTATIVES, BE RIDS ALLEGEDLY CONFIDED TO ONE OF HIS PERSONAL ADVISERS THAT HE WAS CERTAIN THE POLITICAL PARTIES WOULD NEVER BE ABLE TO SET ASIDE THEIR PERSONAL JEALOUSIES/ANBITIONS TO FORMULATE A NEW ELECTORAL LAW THAT WOULD BE AGREEABLE TO ALL THEREFORE, IT WOULD BE UP TO HIM (\$10) TO FORM A COMMITTEE AND OVERSEE THE PROJECT.
