Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), I hereby request the following:

A report documenting the work of the Office of Special Investigations (OSI), the preparation of which was authorized by former Attorney General Janet Reno in 1999. The report was prepared by Judy Feigin, a career DOJ attorney, and edited by Mark Richard, former Deputy Assistant Attorney General of the Criminal Division.


If you regard any of this document as potentially exempt from the FOIA's disclosure requirements, I request that you nonetheless exercise your discretion to disclose it in keeping with President Obama's January 21, 2009, memorandum on the FOIA, which clearly expressed a presumption in favor of disclosure.

As the FOIA requires, please release all reasonably segregable nonexempt portions of the document. To permit me to reach an intelligent and informed decision about whether and how to file an administrative appeal of any denied material, please describe any withholdings and explain the basis for your exemption claims.

As a representative of the news media, the National Security Archive qualifies for "representative of the news media" status under 5 U.S.C. Sec. 552(a)(4)(A)(ii)(II) and, therefore, may not be charged search and review fees. (See *National Security Archive v. U.S. Department of Defense*, 880 F.2d 1381 (D.C.Cir. 1989), cert denied, 110 S Ct. 1478 (1990)). This request is made as part of a scholarly and news research project that is intended for publication and is not for commercial use.
