WEST AND SOUTH OF BERLIN, WITH SOV TANK DIVISION IN POSITIONS SOUTH OF CITY. IMPRESSIVE MILITARY SHOW OF STRENGTH OBVIOUSLY DESIGNED TO INTIMIDATE PEOPLE FROM OUTSET, AND THUS NIP IN BUD ANY POSSI-BLE RESISTANCE. SOV MILITARY PRESENCE PRESUMABLY HAD PURPOSE MÁKE CLEAR FROM BEGINNING THAT CIVILIAN DISOBEDIENCE WOULD BE RUTHLESSLY SUPPRESSED, INVOKING MEMORIES OF 1953; IT ALSO CAST INTERESTING LIGHT ON SOV EVALUATION OF EAST GERMAN MILITARY RELIABILITY.

IT INTERESTING TO NOTE THAT WESTERN OBSERVERS (BRITISH AND AMERICAN MILITARY AND CIVILIAN PERSONNEL DISPATCHED TO SOVSECTOR AND PUTSDAM MISSION PERSONNEL IN ZONE) ENCOUNTERED NO DIFFICULTY; AS INDICATED BERLIN'S 183 DEPT, 157 BONN, VOPOS APPEARED UN-USUALLY CAREFUL NOT TO OBSTRUCT FREEDOM OF ALLIED CIRCULATION.

EAST GERMAN MEASURES CLEARLY DESIGNED TO HALT STREAM OF REFUGEES BY PREVENTING EAST SECTOR AND ZONE RESIDENTS FROM ENTERING WEST BERLIN, WHILE ALLOWING TRAFFIC FROM WEST BERLIN TO PROCEED UNIMPEDED. NEVERTHELESS, REFERENCE IN INTERIOR MINISTRY DECREE (BERLIN'S 178 DEPT, 152 BONN) TO "PEACEFUL CITIZENS FROM WEST BERLIN" FORESHADOWS POSSIBILITY EAST MAY UNDER ITS OWN DEFINITION OF "PEACEFUL" RESTRICT CERTAIN WEST BERLINERS FROM ENTERING EAST BERLIN. SAME APPLIES TO LANGUAGE IN GOR COUNCIL OF MINISTERS! RESOLUTION (BERLIN'S 184 DEPTEL 158 BONN) RE KEEPING "REVANCHIST" WEST GERMANS OUT OF EAST BERLIN.

MISSION OFFICERS OBSERVED DURING AFTERNOON THAT CONTPOL MEASURES DECREED BY GOR REGIME BEING IMPLEMENTED EVERYWHERE. BORDER BETWEEN EAST AND WEST SECTORS CURRENTLY MANNED BY SECURITY ALERT POLICE, DISTRICT ALERT POLICE AND VOPOS, WHO ARE BUILDING OBSTACLES AND STRINGING BARBED WIRE AT BORDER POINTS CLOSED BY REGIME DECREES. AERIAL OBSERVATION SHOWS RELATIVELY FEW TROOP MOVEMENTS DURING DAY AFTER FORCES HAD ASSUMED PUSITIONS. STATUS OF CONTROLS FROM SOVZONE INTO EAST SECTOR NOT YET CLEAR, BUT RELATIVELY FREE FLOW TRAFFIC OBSERVED TO SCHOENEFELD AIRPORT IN SOVZONE JUST OUTSIDE EAST BERLIN. VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC FROM WEST BERLIN MOVING FREELY THROUGH 13 EAST-WEST SECTOR CROSSING POINTS. AUTOBAHN TRAFFIC TO AND FROM FEDREP PROCEEDING NORMALLY.

BRANDENBURGER TOR. HEAVILY ARMED SECURITY ALERT POLICE AND KAMPFGRUPPEN CONTINGENTS REINFORCED AT SEVERAL MAJOR EAST-WEST SECTOR CROSSING POINTS, TOGETHER WITH VOPOS, EVERYWHERE ABLE TO CONTROL CROWDS THAT HAVE FORMED SO FAR. 24 TANKS AND 2C ARMORED TROOP CARRIERS OF EAST GERMAN ARMY, AND 80-90 TRUCKS OBSERVED PARKED IN CENTER OF CITY AND OCCASIONAL MOVEMENTS OF MILITARY VEHICLES SEEN ELSEWHERE.

ALTHOUGH EAST REGIME HAS NOT SO FAR PUBLISHED REGULATION INDICATING EXACT PROCEDURE BY WHICH SOYZONE AND EAST BERLIN RESIDENTS MIGHT OBTAIN PERMITS TO ENTER WEST BERLIN UNDER NEW DECREE, WEST BERLIN POLICE REPORT STATES SOYZONE MARRIED COUPLE WERE TODAY GIVEN ONE-DAY PERMIT TO ENTER WEST BERLIN TO ATTEND FAMILY PARTY. SENAT REPORTS THAT BETWEEN YESTERDAY NOON AND 10 A.M. TODAY 3,190 REFUGEES REPORTED AT RECEPTION CENTER AND ANOTHER 800 REFUGEES BETWEEN 10 AM. AND 4 P.M.; LATTER EITHER CAME TO WEST BERLIN YESTERDAY OR CROSSED THROUGH CANALS AND FIELDS TODAY.
