Subject: Prospective Soviet Responses to
US Action (C)

We submit an amended version of paragraph 6 of our memorandum:

"6. In summation, the Council feels that the most likely Soviet reactions would be at sea, in Iran and a possible ICBM 'accident' on the Pacific Test Site (Johnston Island). Berlin reaction would be sharp and strong, but would be short of direct military seizure. Reactions in other areas are possible as discussed above."
