

In the most recent clash (date not identified) two outstanding Russian Army Officers were killed. All the Chinese force involved (Officers and Soldiers) were killed because the Russians moved sufficient combat troops to the area to outnumber the Chinese forces. Continued border clashes were bound to escalate and require the commitment of larger and larger forces on each side. | | |

(3) Russian Relations. Employment of major forces between Russia and China would probably initiate WWIII. Russia expected that their eventual ally would be the US since they could not conceive of the US helping China.

Colonel Duvall notes that Krakhmalov's only word of caution involved the use of tactical weapons against the Chinese on Russian soil. Krakhmalov said "Of course, the use of nuclear weapons is my personal idea." He added that it would be nice to have the USSR and the United States fighting together once again.
