### (1) ERADICATION

THE 1997 LETTER OF AGREEMENT ON NARCOTICS CONTROL BETWEEN THE USG AND GOC, SET THE GOAL TO SPRAY 25,000 HECTARES OF COCA AND 5,000 HECTARES OF OPIUM POPPY DURING 1997. BOTH GOALS WERE SURPASSED IN AUGUST-THE WEEK OF AUGUST 13 FOR OPIUM POPPY AND THE WEEK OF AUGUST 20 FOR COCA.

- SATLOC/PATHLINK DATA REPORTED THE FOLLOWING:

AUGUST - FROM JULY 30 TO SEPT 2, 4,354 HECTARES OF COCA CULTIVATIONS WERE SPRAYED AND 1,090 HECTARES OF OPIUM POPPY. THERE WERE 242 MISSIONS FLOWN.

SEPT - FROM SEPT 2-30, 2,045 HECTARES OF COCA CULTIVATIONS WERE SPRAYED AND 686.7 HECTARES OF OPIUM POPPY. THERE WERE 143 MISSIONS FLOWN.

OCT - FROM OCT 1-28, 1,716.66 HECTARES OF COCA CULTIVATIONS WERE SPRAYED AND 275 HECTARES OF OPIUM POPPY. THERE WERE 91 MISSIONS FLOWN.

NOV - FROM OCT 29-NOV 25, 2,290.42 HECTARES OF COCA CULTIVATIONS WERE SPRAYED AND 50 HECTARES OF OPIUM POPPY. THERE WERE 86

INVESTIGATIVE TEAM FROM INL'S AIR WING DIVISION AT PATRICK AIR FORCE BASE IN FLORIDA JOIN THE CNP TEAM TO REVIEW THE CIRCUMSTANCES INVOLVING THE INCIDENT. PRELIMINARY REPORTS INDICATE THAT THE ACCIDENT WAS DUE TO MECHANICAL FAILURE. THE AIRCRAFT WAS RETURNED TO THE U.S. FOR REPAIR.

THE PARTS WERE A DONATION TO THE GOC ANTI-DRUG PROGRAM.

- AN INL/USDA ERADICATION REVIEW TEAM PARTICIPATED IN MEETINGS IN BOGOTA AND FIELD SITE VISITS ON OCT 28-NOV 4. THEY REVIEWED HERBICIDE APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND RELATED ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES AND EVALUATED RANDOMLY-SELECTED SPRAYED FIELDS. IMPROVEMENTS IN SPRAY OPERATIONS HAVE RESULTED FROM THIS MEETING, WHICH MORE VIGOROUSLY APPROACHED RELEVANT ISSUES THAT HAD BEEN RAISED IN EARLIER MEETINGS BETWEEN THE USG TEAM AND THE COLOMBIAN GOVERNMENT'S ENVIRONMENTAL AUDITOR (SEE BOGOTA 10640).

- FOUR FUEL TANKERS ENROUTE TO THE CNP BASE IN SAN JOSE DEL GUAVIRARE WERE INTERCEPTED BY GUERRILLAS ON NOV 7. MOTOR FUEL TANKERS WERE ALLOWED TO CONTINUE, BUT AIRCRAFT FUEL (PURCHASED BY UNCLASSIFIED

PAGE 03 BOGOTA 11391 02 OF 06 031939Z NAS) WERE FORCED TO RETURN TO THEIR DEPOTS WITH STRONG WARNINGS. THE PROBLEM OF GETTING AIRCRAFT FUEL TO THE FOL'S IS BEING STUDIED. NO RESOLUTION HAS BEEN REACHED.

- SIX USG-OWNED UH-1H'S ARRIVED NOV 8 TO BE EXCLUSIVELY ASSIGNED TO SECURITY ESCORT IN THE AERIAL ERADICATION PROGRAM FOR BOTH SPRAY AND VERIFICATION OPERATIONS. THE HELOS WERE ARMORED SOON UPON ARRIVAL. A 2-MAN TEAM OF WEAPONS EXPERTS THEN TRAVELED TO BOGOTA NOV 16-25 TO INSTALL MINIGUN WEAPONS SYSTEMS IN THE SIX HELOS. THE TEAM ALSO DELIVERED ADDITIONAL BADLY NEEDED SPARE PARTS FOR THE CNP-OWNED MINIGUNS.
- THE SIX UH-1H'S WILL BE PILOTED BY U.S. CONTRACT PILOTS AND CO-PILOTED BY CNP PILOTS WITH THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT. NAS IS AIMING TO PROVIDE THE JUNIOR CNP PILOTS WITH THE BEST ON-THE-JOB TRAINING AVAILABLE BY ASSIGNING THE PILOTS TO WORK ON U.S. WORK SCHEDULES. THE TEAM CONCEPT WILL BE RIGOROUSLY EMPHASIZED, AS THESE HELICOPTERS PARTICIPATE IN POSSIBLY THE MOST DANGEROUS FLYING IN THE SO-CALLED DRUG WAR.
