

1) I have listened very carefully to your statements this morning ^{generally} concerning the state of our negotiations and specifically your reactions to the very constructive proposals put forward by President Carter yesterday. I must frankly tell you that I am disappointed. Your response ignores the very great effort of President Carter to meet your concerns while providing equal security for both sides. I hope and expect that you ~~will study~~ and your colleagues in Moscow will study carefully what President Carter said to you yesterday.

2) I will ^{not} attempt to comment on all # of the matters which are unresolved. The fact that I have not commented on a particular issue and this should not be taken as any indication of agreement with the Soviet position. ^{or point issue} Furthermore, I want to make crystal clear that agreement on ~~all~~ each specific issue is conditional on agreement all the issues.
