Elvis Presley came to the White Hew c on December 21, 1970. As had informed certain White House Staff members that he vanted to report to the Fresic of an some of the activities: (this includes financial support and public statements as dispersiones on assult of law enforcement) he had undertaken in support at law enforcement throughout the country and colors efforts to fight dray abuse through his public performances.

He briefy sketched for the President In activities and then pointed out how much he loved his country, always felt that he had to do his detre for his country, his friends, and his family.
