1. AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE U.S. NUCLEAR TEAM VISIT ON 27 MAY, DR. VICTOR CHENG INDICATED THAT IN VIEW OF THE HIA-TUS IN INER ACTIVITIES, IT WOULD BE HELPFUL IN DEALING WITH OTHER ROC GOVERNMENT AGENCIES IF HE COULD RECEIVE SOME INDI-CATION OF THE TEAM'S REACTION TO THE ACTIVITIES DISCUSSED DURING THE VISIT. WHILE THE USG DOES NOT WISH TO BECOME INVOLVED IN FORMAL REVIEW AND APPROVAL PROCEDURES ON ROC NUCLEAR ACTIVITIES, IT DOES SEEM APPROPRIATE, IN VIEW OF THE DRASTIC REORIENTATION REQUIRED OF INER'S ACTIVITIES, TO PROVIDE OUR PRELIMINARY VIEWS ON THE TYPES OF CONTINUING ACTIVITIES PROPOSED BY INER. IN RESPONSE TO YOUR INQUIRY ABOUT OUR REACTION TO INDIVIDUAL ACTIVITIES OF THE DRAFT RESEARCH PROGRAM DIS-CUSSED DURING THIS VISIT, I WOULD LIKE TO CONFIRM THAT, BASED UPON THIS PRELIMINARY INFORMATION, IT WOULD APPEAR THAT THE PROGRAMS ARE GENERALLY CONSISTENT WITH THE NOTE OF APRIL 12, 1977, WITH THE FOLLOWING QUALIFI-THE WORK RELATING TO SEPARATION OF AMERICIUM FROM PLUTONIUM WILL TER; INATE UPON COMPLETION OF PRO-CESSING OF PLUTONIUM ALREADY DISSOLVED AND ALL PLUTONIUM WILL BE CONVERTED TO OXIDE FOR RETURN TO THE U.S.; THE WORK RELATING TO SEPARATION OF U-233 WILL BE TERMINATED; ACTIVITIES RELATIN; TO ADVANCED REACTOR DESIGN WILL BE LIMITED TO STUDIES PENDING FURTHER REVIEW; AND NO ACT-IVITIES BASED ON TRR OPERATION WILL BE INITIATED PENDING THE ACCEPTABLE RESOLUTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE THREE AREAS OF CONCERN.
