- 10. (Internal Use Only LLM) Emerson Brown, State Department. called for a final review of State's proposed response to OMB on the unauthorized disclosure legislation. Brown admitted that State had already received our views but in the interest of avoiding any possible problem between us, which we might still be able to resolve, he agreed to LDX a copy of State's final draft position so that we would have at least one more chance on a meeting of minds and eliminate any unnecessary . contentions. State's draft reply has been sent to Mr. Warner, OGC. See Memorandum to Mr. Warner of 20 May 75 for details.
- 11. (Unclassified BAA) Jane McMullan, Senate Appropriations Committee staff, asked if she could have the names of the Senators who appeared at briefings of the Intelligence Operations Subcommittee since the beginning of this year. I told Ms. McMullan that I would check on this and be back in touch.
- 12. (Unclassified CG) Dorothy Kornegay, Secretary, Senate Government Operations Subcommittee on Intergovernmental Relations, 25X1 called to notify us of the jacket number (44-826) for the 9 and 10 December 1974 hearings, "Legislative Proposals to Strengthen Congressional Oversight of the Nation's Intelligence Agencies." I subsequently called Acquisitions, and requested 75 copies. He later called back to say that GPO told him the hearing had already been printed on 16 May.
- 13. (Confidential PLC) As requested by John Morfit, Executive Secretary, Scientific Intelligence Committee, USIB, gave to Dick Kimmel, Joint Committee on Atomic Energy staff, a copy of the SIC publication, "Military Implications of Technology Transfer to the Soviet Union" SIC 75/1, April 1975.
- 14. (Confidential PLC) Left with Mary Kay O'Hara, Receptionist in the office of Senator James L. Buckley (R., N.Y.), a copy of the Agency's interim letter to their constituent, requesting further 25X1 biographic data. I advised Ms. O'Hara that to date we have not heard from the constituent.
