MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT BREZHNEV CONCERNING RECENT PRESS REPORTS OF A PURPORTED "ALERT" OF AMERICAN STRATEGIC FORCES. BECAUSE THE ORAL MESSAGE WAS BASED ON INACCURATE AND MISLEADING INFORMATION, THE ASSERTIONS IN THE MESSAGE ARE INACCURATE AND UNACCEPTABLE TO THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT.

-- THE LEVEL OF ALERT OF U.S. STRATEGIC OFFENSIVE FORCES

WAS NOT RAISED ABOVE ITS USUAL LEVEL BECAUSE THE U.S. COMMAND AND CONTROL SYSTEM ASSURES REVIEW AND CONTROL BY RESPONSIBLE OFFICIALS AT ALL LEVELS. IT DOES NOT SERVE THE PURPOSES OF PEACE OR STRATEGIC STABILITY FOR THE SOVIET UNION TO BASE ITS ACTIONS OR ITS DIPLOMATIC EX-CHANGES ON PRESS REPORTS OR TO PROPAGANDIZE SUCH MATTERS BEFORE FINDING OUT THE TRUE FACTS. THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT ASSURES THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT BOTH THAT ITS LOCAL COMMANDERS HAVE AND WILL EXERCISE THE AUTHORITY TO PUT THEIR FORCES IN CONDITION TO SURVIVE ATTACK, AND THAT CONTROL OF THE OFFENSIVE USE OF OUR FORCES IS TOTALLY RE-LIABLE, AS WAS DEMONSTRATED IN THIS CASE. WE WOULD WEL-COME SIMILAR INFORMATION FROM THE SOVIET UNION ON ITS COMMAND AND CONTROL PROCEDURES. END TEXT.
