DMS Concerning the Argentine Government's being prepared to consider favorably the conclusion of an agreement among the Western Suppliers of fertile material the U.S. has started preliminary approaches to other MCBONEN. suppliers with regard to establishing a common policy of requiring that IAEA safeguards be applied to materials and equipment supplied to other countries. A formal approach requesting Argentina's participation in this common policy will be made at the appropriate time. The conclusion of a formal agreement among the suppliers is still some time in the future. Even before a common policy is adopted, it is hoped that Argentina will adopt a policy of requiring safeguards on nuclear materials sold to other countries.
