FIELD TRIP TO THE HAGERSTOWN CORRECTIONAL FACILITY SUMMER SCHOLARS LAW AND EVIDENCE: INSIDE CRIMINAL LAW MINI-COURSE

Dear Parent/Guardian,

This permission slip is required by the Hagerstown Correctional Facility to assure them that you are aware that your son or daughter will be visiting the facility for a field trip as part of the activities of the Summer Scholars Law and Evidence Mini-Course. Students may tour the facility or wait in a reception area during the tour. After the tour students will meet with a small group of prisoners specially trained to speak with students about the prison experience. Upon arrival students will be briefed by guards and staff about behavior and protocol. Students will be subject to prison security measures which include scanning with a metal detector and searching bags and purses. Metal detectors at the prison facility are very sensitive and ladies wearing under wire bras will be subject to hand search. Students will be chaperoned at all times by GW chaperones as well as by Correction Facility staff and guards.
