2. AT MEETING WITH AMBASSADOR AFTERNOON OCTOBER TWENTY-SIX, MINISTER OF PRESIDENCY CARLOS FLORES APPLAUDED JOINT US/OECS ACTION IN GRENADA. HE SAID "IT WAS THE BEST THING YOU COULD HAVE DONE. YOU CHOSE WELL AND THIS COULD HAVE VERY FAVORABLE IMPLICATIONS FOR CENTRAL AMERICA." FLORES WENT ON TO EXPRESS THE HOPE THAT THIS DECISIVE ACTION BY USG AND OTHER FRIENDS OF DEMOCRACY IN EASTERN CARIBBEAN WOULD BE HELPFUL IN SOLIDIFYING SUPPORT FOR PRESIDENT REAGAN'S CARIBBEAN BASIN POLICIES.
