1. Arab States -Israel (As of 5:45 AM EDT)

No challenge to the blockade appears likely today and there have been no new military developments overnight.

A tanker is due at Eilat about 31 May, but may be diverted as was a sister ship yesterday. A cargo vessel may enter the Gulf on 30 or 31 May.

U Thant may propose that all nations temporarily hold up strategic cargoes (including oil) normally shipped through the Gulf.

tegic shipping was one of two proposals made by the UN Secretary General during his visit to Cairo. The second proposition was that he send a permanent and personal representative to the Middle East. The Egyptians bought both proposals,
